

GATHERING

The Holy Spirit calls us together as the people of God.

CALL TO WORSHIP

L: In the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

ALL: Amen.

L: Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.

ALL: Blessed is the man against whom the Lord counts no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.

L: For when I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long.

ALL: For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer.

L. I acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not cover my iniquity.

ALL: I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord," and you forgave the iniquity of my sin.

WE CONFESS OUR SIN

(Please be seated as we prepare ourselves for confession through silence and prayerful reflection.)

L: Almighty God, to whom all hearts are open, all desires known, and from whom no secrets are hid: Cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of your Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love you and worthily magnify your holy name, through Jesus Christ our Lord.

ALL: AMEN.

L: Isaiah knew that he was a sinner in the presence of the holy God of Israel. With the prophet, we acknowledge and confess our sins to God and ask for his for-giveness.

ALL: Almighty God, we know that we are sinners. We do not obey your holy law. We follow our sinful desires and listen to the temptations of the world around us. The prophet con-fessed that he was unclean. We too are unclean. We have sinned against you in our thoughts, words and deeds. Have mercy on us and forgive our sins.

Please use the next few moments of SILENCE to offer your heart to God in quiet confession.

L: An angel touched the prophet's lips with a coal from the altar of sacrifice and said, "Your guilt is taken away, and your sin atoned for." Isaiah's guilt was taken away. His sins were forgiven. As God showed grace to the prophet, he has shown his grace to us through Jesus' atoning death. I announce to you that your sins are forgiven in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
